## PEACE OFFICER'S CRASH REPORT

### Texas Transportation Code, Sec. 550.065. Release of Certain Motor Vehicle Accident Report

Texas Transportation Code  550.065 (c)(4) allows for the release of a crash report on written request and upon payment of required fee of any person directly concerned in the accident or having a proper interest therein, including:  (A) Any person involved in the accident  (B) The authorized representative of any person involved in the accident  (C) A driver involved in the accident  (D) An employer, parent or legal guardian of a driver involved in the accident  (E) The owner of a vehicle or property damaged in the accident  (F) A person who has established financial responsibility for a vehicle involved in the accident in a manner described by TTC Section 601.501, including a policy holder of a motor vehicle liability insurance policy covering the vehicle  (G) An insurance company that issued an insurance policy covering a vehicle involved in the accident  (H) An insurance company that issued a policy covering any person involved in the accident  (I) A person under contract to provide claims or underwriting information to a person described by Paragraph (F), (G), or (H);  (J) A radio or television station that holds a license issued by the Federal Communications Commission  (K) A newspaper is:

- i: A free newspaper of general circulation or qualified under Section 2051.044, Government Code, to publish legal notices;
- ii: Publish at least once a week; and
- iii: Available and of interest to the general public in connection with the dissemination of news  (L)

Any person who may sue because of death resulting from the accident

OR  An agency of the United States, this state (Texas) or a local government of this state (Texas)  I do not meet any of the qualifications listed above, however, I certify that I am a person directly concerned in the accident or have a proper interest therein. Please provide an explanation for how you meet this requirement.
